



**SUGGESTED ITINERARY:-**  
**07 NIGHTS / 8 DAYS**

**JAIPUR 02 UDAIPUR 02 JODHPUR 01 JAISALMER 02**

**Day 01 : Delhi to Jaipur (Approx.280 Kms. / 05-06 hrs.)**

Arrive Delhi / Jaipur and proceed to Jaipur check into the hotel in Jaipur. Take rest in the evening visit **Birla Manadir**. Dinner and overnight stay at Hotel in Jaipur.

**Day 02 : Jaipur sightseeing**

Morning after early breakfast, visit Amber fort. **Amber Fort** was the ancient capital of the state. visit the sheesh mahal or the hall of victory glittering with mirrors. Ascend the fort on elephant back. Afternoon tour of Jaipur. the capital of Rajasthan was given a colour coat of pink a century ago in honour of a visiting prince and ever since, it has retained this colour. built by Maharaja Jai Singh, the notable astronomer, this city is 260 years old. **Visit Maharaja's city palace, Jantar Mantar & Ram Niwas gardens**. Drive pass **Hawa Mahal &** through the pink rose residential & business areas. Overnight stay at hotel in Jaipur.

**Day 03 : Jaipur to Udaipur (Approx. 400 Kms. / 7-8 hrs.)**

After breakfast, checkout from hotel and proceed to Udaipur. Check in Hotel and take some rest. In the evening take a breathtaking boat tour over the picturesque **Lake Pichola** (at your own cost) to admire the royal buildings around the Lake and enjoy the scenic sunset view. From the lake you have a wonderful view of the City Palace stretching along the east bank, while the south bank has pleasant gardens running down to the waterside. Overnight stay at Hotel in Udaipur.

**Day 04: Udaipur Local Sightseeing**

After breakfast start for Udaipur city tour. Visiting **Fateh Sagar, Maharana Pratap Memorial**, take a photo stop at **Nehru Garden, Sehelion-KI-Bari - Queen's resort for their friends, Sukhadia Circle (Drive Pass), Bhartiya Lok kala Museum** - a museum of folk and art, it displays a rich collection of folk dresses, ornaments, puppets, masks, dolls. After that visit **City Palace** - The largest palace complex of Rajasthan, **Jagdish Temple** - built by Maharana Jagat Singh and is dedicated to Lord Vishnu & Gulab Bagh. Overnight stay at Udaipur.

**Day 05 : Udaipur to Jodhpur: (Approx. 250 Kms. / 5-6 Hrs.)**

After breakfast, checkout from hotel, Proceed to Jodhpur, the Second Largest city in Rajasthan. The city is known as the "Sun City" because of its bright and sunny weather throughout the year. On arrival, check in at hotel and Relax. start local sightseeing Covering **Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum & Mehrangarh Fort**- situated on a low sandstone hill. Within the fort visit **Moti Mahal and Phool Mahal**. **Also visit Jaswant Thada** - an imposing marble cenotaph built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II around 1899, **Kaylana Lake and Mandore Garden**. Evening enjoy at local market. Overnight stay at hotel in Jodhpur.



**Day 06 : Jodhpur to Jaisalmer: (Approx. 285 Kms. / 5 Hrs.)**

Arrival Jodhpur / Jaisalmer and transferred to Jaisalmer – The Golden City . On reaching check-in the hotel and relax for some time. Later enjoy a half day sightseeing of **Vyas Chhatri & Gadisar Lake**. After sightseeing, get back to the hotel and overnight stay in Jaisalmer.

**Day 07 : Jaisalmer Sand Dunes**

After your breakfast at the hotel, checkout from hotel and then you will first enjoy a half day sightseeing tour of Jaisalmer city till 4 pm, where you will visit **Jaisalmer Golden Fort, Patwon & Salim Singh haveli, Jain temples & other stunning haveli's** of Jaisalmer Fort. By 4 PM arrive at the booked desert camp (at Sam sand dune) and enjoy Desert Camp experiences:-

1. Get traditional welcome Rajasthani style at desert camp
2. 01 time : Enjoy Camel Safari (2 Pax, 1 Camel)
3. Evening Tea/Coffee and Cookies / Snacks (After Sunset in Camp at Courtyard/Dance Area).
4. Rajasthani Folk Dance and Cultural Activities
5. Bon Fire / Group DJ Music Dance in Winters only
6. Rajasthani Veg. Traditional Dinner at Camp
- 7. 01 time : Enjoy Adventure Jeep Safari with Sunset at Thar Desert on sharing basis**

**Day 08 : Jaisalmer to Jodhpur (Approx. - 285 Kms. / 05-06 Hrs.)**

After breakfast, checkout from hotel and proceed to Jodhpur. Transfer to Jodhpur Airport for your onward journey.
