Day1 Chandigarh to Shimla

Pick and Greet at Chandigarh, Travel to Shimla 120km 4-5hr journey, on way Visist Pinjore garden and Transfer to Hotel Check in Hotel Rest. Overnight at Hotel.

About Shimla/City in Himachal Pradesh

Description Shimla is the capital of the northern Indian state of Himachal Pradesh, in the Himalayan foothills. Once the summer capital of British India, it remains the terminus of the narrow-gauge Kalka-Shimla Railway, completed in 1903. It's also known for the handicraft shops that line The Mall, a pedestrian avenue, as well as the Lakker Bazaar, a market specializing in wooden toys and crafts.

Yadavindra Gardens, Pinjore/Garden in Pinjore, Haryana

Yadavindra Gardens, also known as Pinjore Gardens, is a historic 17th century garden located in Pinjore city of Panchkula district in the Indian state of Haryana. It is an example of the Mughal Gardens architectural style, which was renovated by the Patiala Dynasty Sikh Rulers.

Place to Visist -Lakker Bazaar-Kali Bari Temple/Gaiety Heritage Cultural Complex/Scandal Point/Shimla Christ Church-Ridge/Johannie's Wax Museum)

Christ Church-Ridge/Place of worship in Shimla, Himachal Pradesh

Christ Church, Shimla, is the second oldest church in North India, after St John's Church in Meerut. It is a parish in the Diocese of Amritsar in the Church of North India. Its current incumbent is The Rev. Sohan Lal, whose ecclesiastical designation is presbyter-in-charge. Worship is conducted in Hindi and English.

Lakker Bazaar Shimla

Indian Institute of Advanced Study

Description The Indian Institute of Advanced Study is a research institute based in Shimla, India. It was set up by the Ministry of Education, Government of India in 1964 and it started functioning from 20 October 1965.



Johnnie's Wax Museum /Museum in Shimla, Himachal Pradesh

Modest attraction featuring life-sized wax figures of local & international icons.

Description -Kufri is a small hill station in Shimla district of Himachal Pradesh state in India. It is located 20 km from the state capital Shimla on the National Highway No.22. The name Kufri is derived from the word kufri meaning "lake" in the local language.

Elevation: 2,720 m/Population: 1,148 (2001).

Day3- Shimla to Manali by Taxi

Morning after Breakfast checkout and travel to Manali by taxi (260 km 7-9 hr journey)

Place to Visits –On Way Visit Pandoh Dam, Hanogi Temple and valley view, Kullu shawl factory/River rafting point/Paragliding Point, Vaishno Devi Mata Temple, and Kullu Shawl Industry. And drop at Hotel

Pandoh Dam/Body of water

The Pandoh Dam is an embankment dam on the Beas River in Mandi district of Himachal Pradesh, India. Under the Beas Project, the dam was completed in 1977 and its primary purpose is hydroelectric power generation.

Rafting and white water rafting are recreational outdoor activities which use an inflatable raft to navigate a river or other body of water. This is often done on whitewater or different degrees of rough water. Dealing with risk and the need for teamwork is often a part of the experience

Paragliding

Paragliding is the recreational and competitive adventure sport of flying paragliders: lightweight, free-flying, foot-launched glider aircraft with no rigid primary structure. The pilot sits in a harness or lies supine in a cocoon-like 'speed bag' suspended below a fabric wing

Manali/Town in Himachal Pradesh

Description Manali is a high-altitude Himalayan resort town in India's northern Himachal Pradesh state. It has a reputation as a backpacking center and honeymoon destination. Set on the Beas River, it's a gateway for skiing in the Solang Valley and trekking in Parvati Valley. It's also a jumping-off point for paragliding, rafting and mountaineering in the Pir Panjal mountains, home to 4,000m-high Rohtang Pass. Elevation: 2,050 m/Weather: 23 °C, Wind S at 8 km/h, 87% Humidity

Hindu temple in Manali, Himachal Pradesh

Description Hadimba Devi Temple, locally known as Dhungari Temple, also known variously as the Hadimba Temple, is located in Manali, a hill station in the State of Himāchal Pradesh in north India. It is an ancient cave temple dedicated to Hadimba Devi, wife of Bhīma, a figure in the Indian epic Mahabharata.

Day5-Manali Solang and Atul Tunnel Manali Sight Seeing

Morning after Breakfast Visit Day Sight Seeing. Overnight at Hotel

Place to Visits -Nehru Kund and Solang Valley->Solang Nala derives its name from combination of words Solang and Nallah. It is a side valley at the top of the Kullu Valley in Himachal Pradesh, India 14 km northwest of the resort town Manali on the way to Rohtang Pass, and is known for its summer and winter sport conditions.

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Atal Tunnel Sightseeing -

Atal Tunnel is a highway tunnel built under the Rohtang Pass in the eastern Pir Panjal range of the Himalayas on the Leh-Manali Highway in Himachal Pradesh, India. At a length of 9.02 km, it is the longest tunnel above 10,000 feet in the world and is named after former Prime Minister of India, Atal Bihari Vajpayee. Length: 9.02 km /Width: 10 m/Route: Leh Manali Highway
